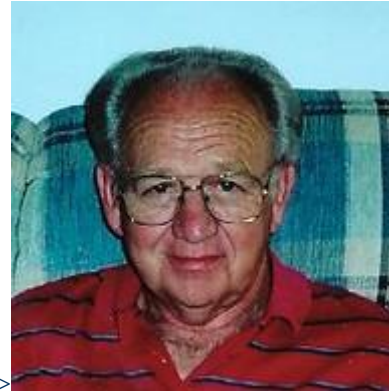
Born March 14, 1937, in his grandfather's residence in Purdum, he was a son of the late William Earl and Edna Laury Smith Thompson.
